

Spanish Basic I

Course Overview

Throughout the four weeks students will develop a basic linguistic capacity that allow them to get along in simple communication situations. They will learn basic grammatical structures, vocabulary and the appropriate expressions to communicate with their families and friends, also to interact, handle situations in the restaurant, the store, buses, etc.

The course answers the question: *How to use the four skills of the initial level of Spanish language to communicate and perform in everyday and immediate situations?*

To answer this question the following topics will be studied:

- Greeting people.
- Introduce yourself and introduce others
- Describe people, animals, places and objects.
- Narrate daily situations.
- Formulate questions and responses

The following skills will be promoted throughout the course:

- Basic ability to pronounce in Spanish.
- Basic ability to write in Spanish about simple situations.
- Basic ability to understand simple situations in Spanish, both oral and written.
