Course Overview

Upon completion of the course, students will gain a sufficient linguistic capacity allowing them to understand, describe, narrate, and interact quite accurately in the target language.

Students will gain the ability to address current affairs and culture. In addition, they will acquire precision and agility in the performance of their communicative level.

This is a theoretical-practical course and explores/responds to the following inquiry according to the professional/disciplinary profile: *How can we ensure that the student acquires the communicative competence at the upper intermediate level to develop his or her ideas, through analytical thinking and interpersonal skills?*

To answer this question, the following generative topics will be studied:

- Narrate everyday events and the social environment.
- Describe anecdotes and past experiences.
- Contrast and compare cultural elements.
- Develop hypotheses and conjectures.
